Dasar Privasi

Dasar privasi ini merangkumi maklumat yang dikumpulkan dan amalan penyebaran oleh The Malaysian Current Law Journal Sdn Bhd (selepas ini dikenali sebagai "MCLJ" atau "Kami").

Sebarang perubahan kepada dasar privasi ini akan diberikan kepada anda bersama-sama dengan versi terkini jika anda sediakan alamat surat menyurat kepada Kami. Mana-mana dasar yang disemak semula itu akan terus digunapakai terhadap semua maklumat yang sebelumnya telah dikumpulkan serta maklumat yang telah disimpan atau diproses, secara berterusan oleh Kami.

1. Pengumpulan Maklumat dan Penggunaannya

Kami mungkin memproses maklumat peribadi seperti nama, jawatan, maklumat perhubungan dan maklumat kewangan seperti butir-butir kad kredit apabila anda membeli produk-produk kami. Ia adalah wajib untuk kami memproses maklumat yang dinyatakan dan jika kamu menarik balik persetujuan anda kepada pemrosesan atau menghadkan hak kami untuk memproses maklumat yang dinyatakan, kami mungkin tidak akan dapat memberi perkhidmatan yang diminta secara efektif.

Kami memelihara hak Kami dengan mendedahkan maklumat peribadi anda sekiranya dikehendaki berbuat demikian oleh undang-undang, atau dalam suci hati bahawa tindakan itu adalah perlu secara munasabah untuk mematuhi proses undang-undang, bertindak balas kepada tuntutan, atau untuk melindungi hak, harta atau keselamatan syarikat Kami, pekerja, pengguna, atau orang awam.
