An Act to amend the Passports Act 1966.

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Malaysia as follows:

# Short title and commencement

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Passports (Amendment) Act 2025.
- (2) This Act comes into operation on a date to be appointed by the Minister by notification in the *Gazette*.

# Amendment of section 2

- 2. The Passports Act 1966 [Act 150] is amended in section 2—
  - (a) in subsection (1), by inserting after the words "shall produce to an immigration officer" the words "or provide through an automated system,"; and
  - (b) in subsection (2), by inserting after the words "produce to that officer" the words "or provide through an automated system,".

# **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

This Bill seeks to amend the Passports Act 1966 ("Act 150").

- 2. Clause 1 contains the short title and the provision on the commencement of the proposed Act.
- 3. Clause 2 seeks to amend section 2 of Act 150 to provide that any person entering Malaysia or leaving Malaysia shall provide a passport through an automated system. This clause is a consequential amendment to the proposed amendments of the Immigration Act 1959/63 [Act 155] which requires every person entering Malaysia or leaving Malaysia to be examined by the immigration officer or through an automated system.

This Bill will not involve the Government in any extra financial expenditure.
